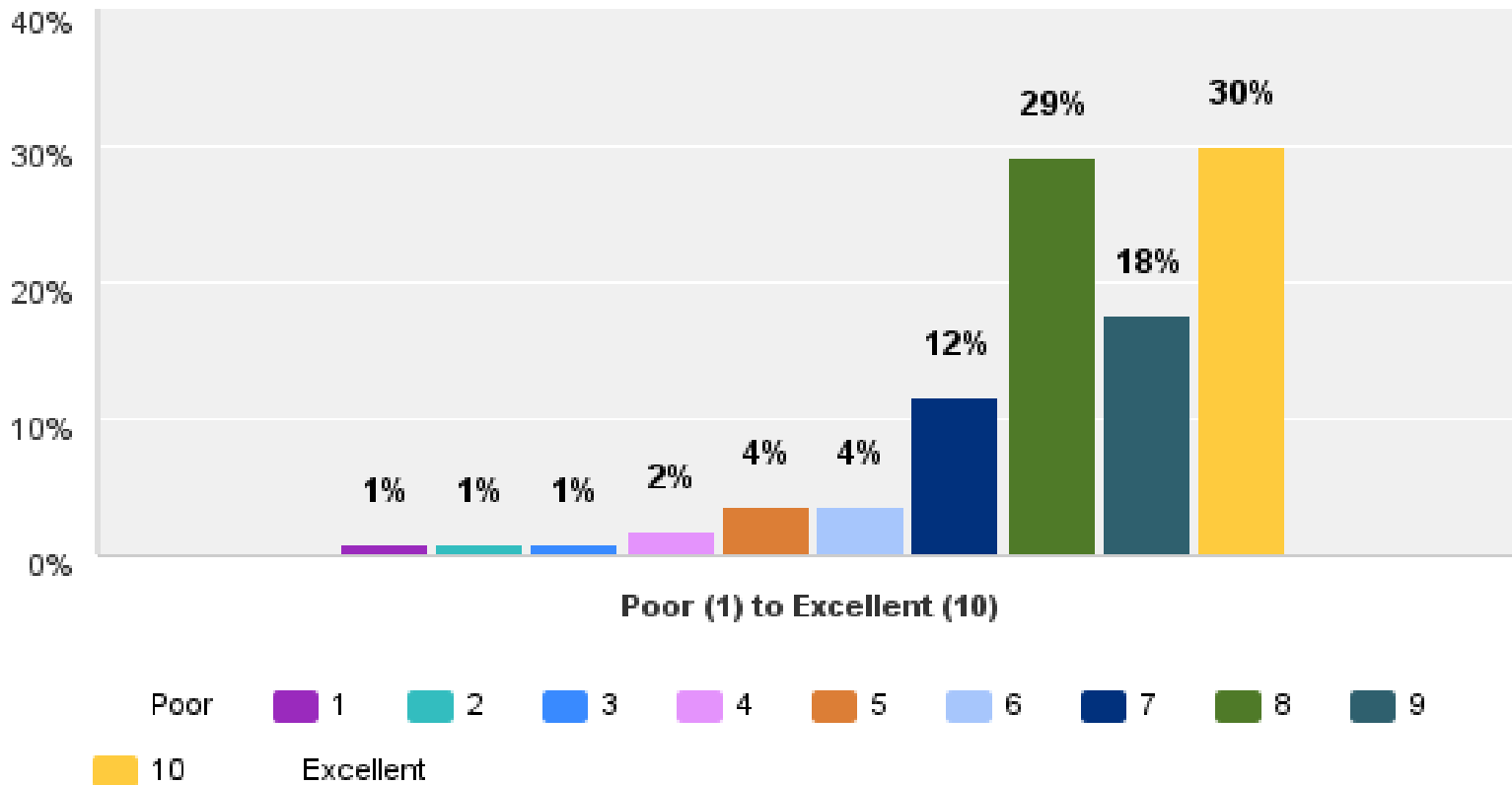
- Took our Women's Issues Survey online with SurveyMonkey

Planned Goals

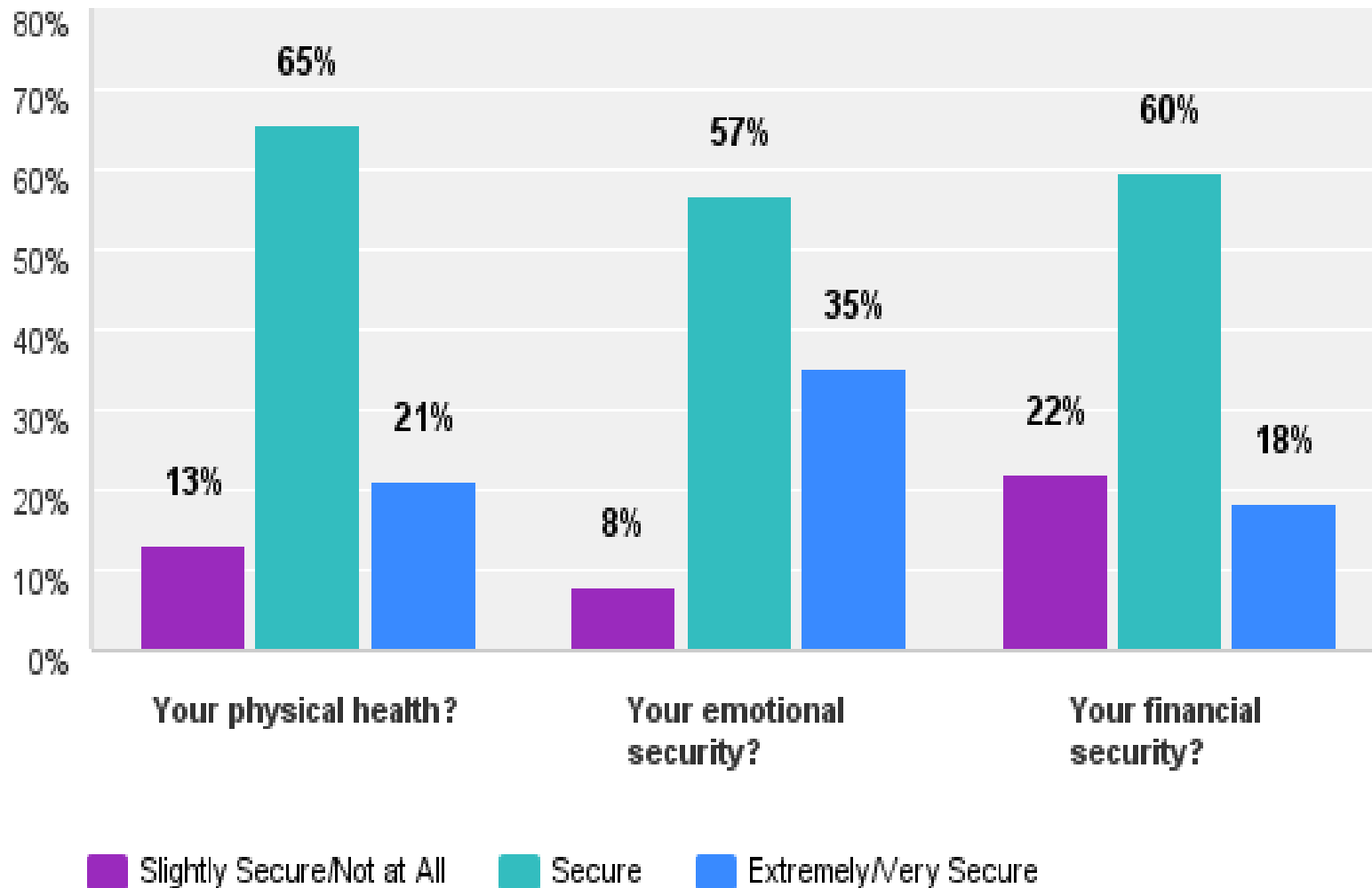
- Obtain a Fully Appointed Commission

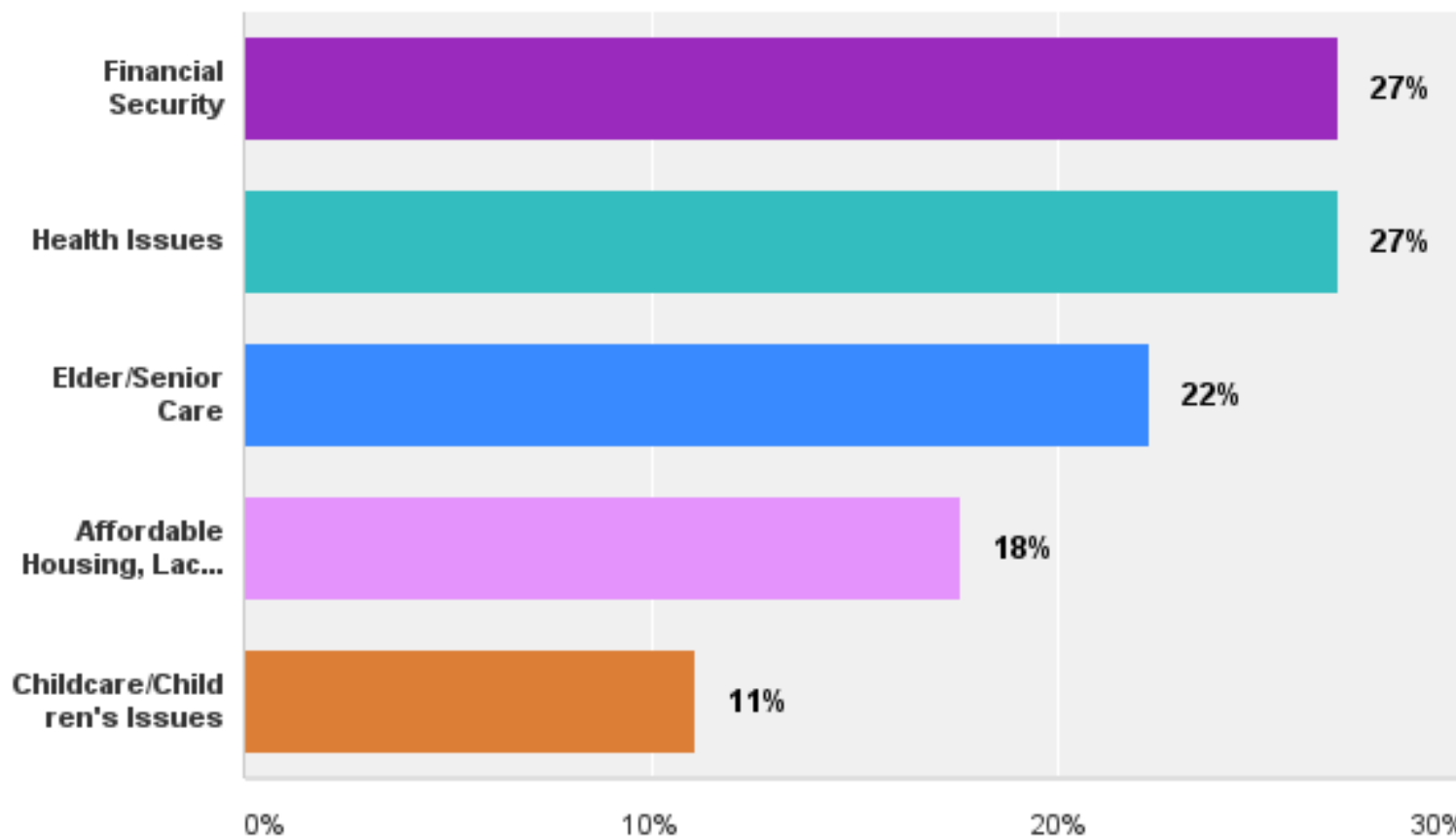
Q1: How do you rate the overall quality of life for you and your family here in San Luis Obispo County?



Q2: How secure do you feel about:

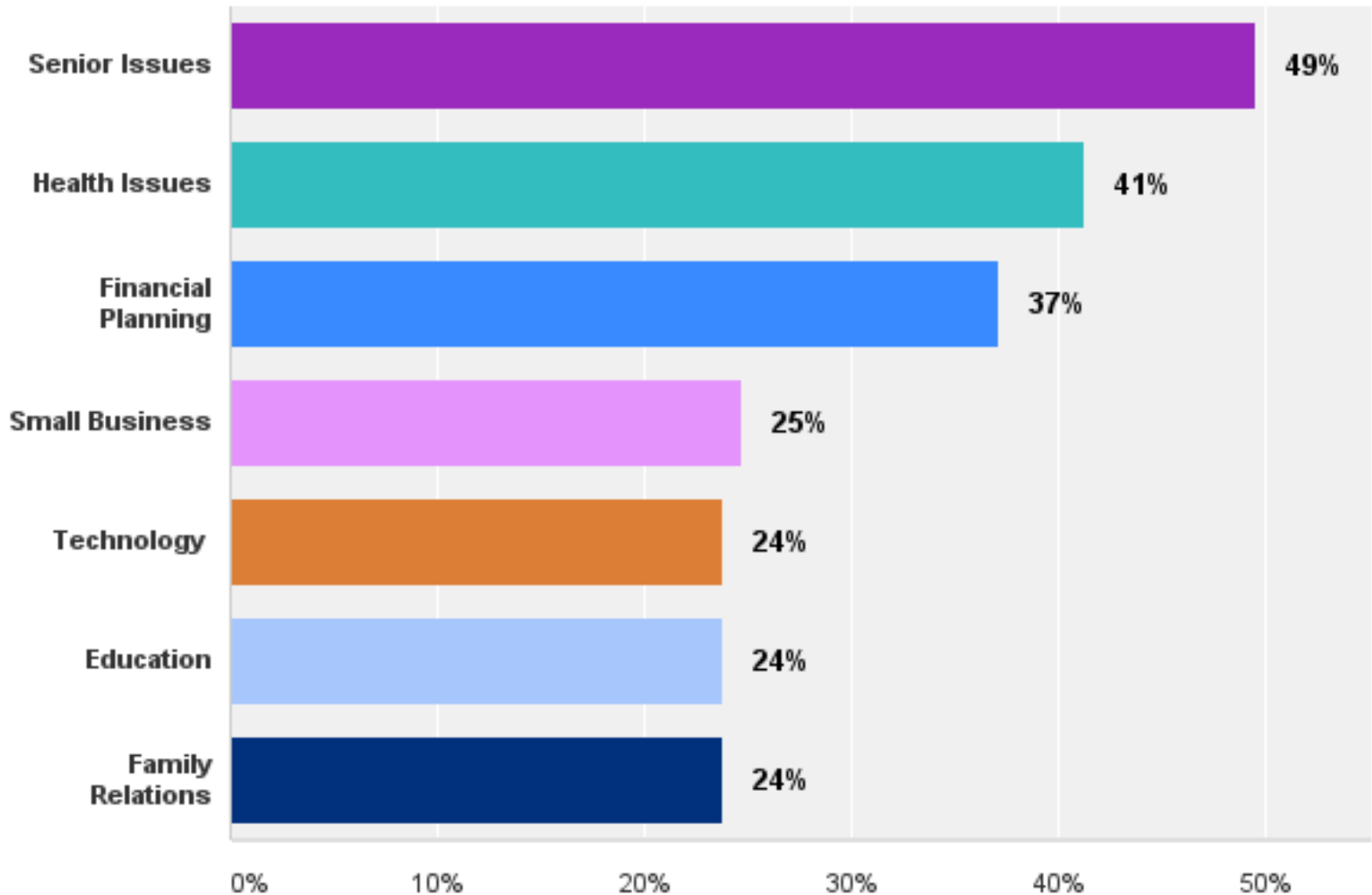


Q3: Which of the following issues are you dealing with right now?

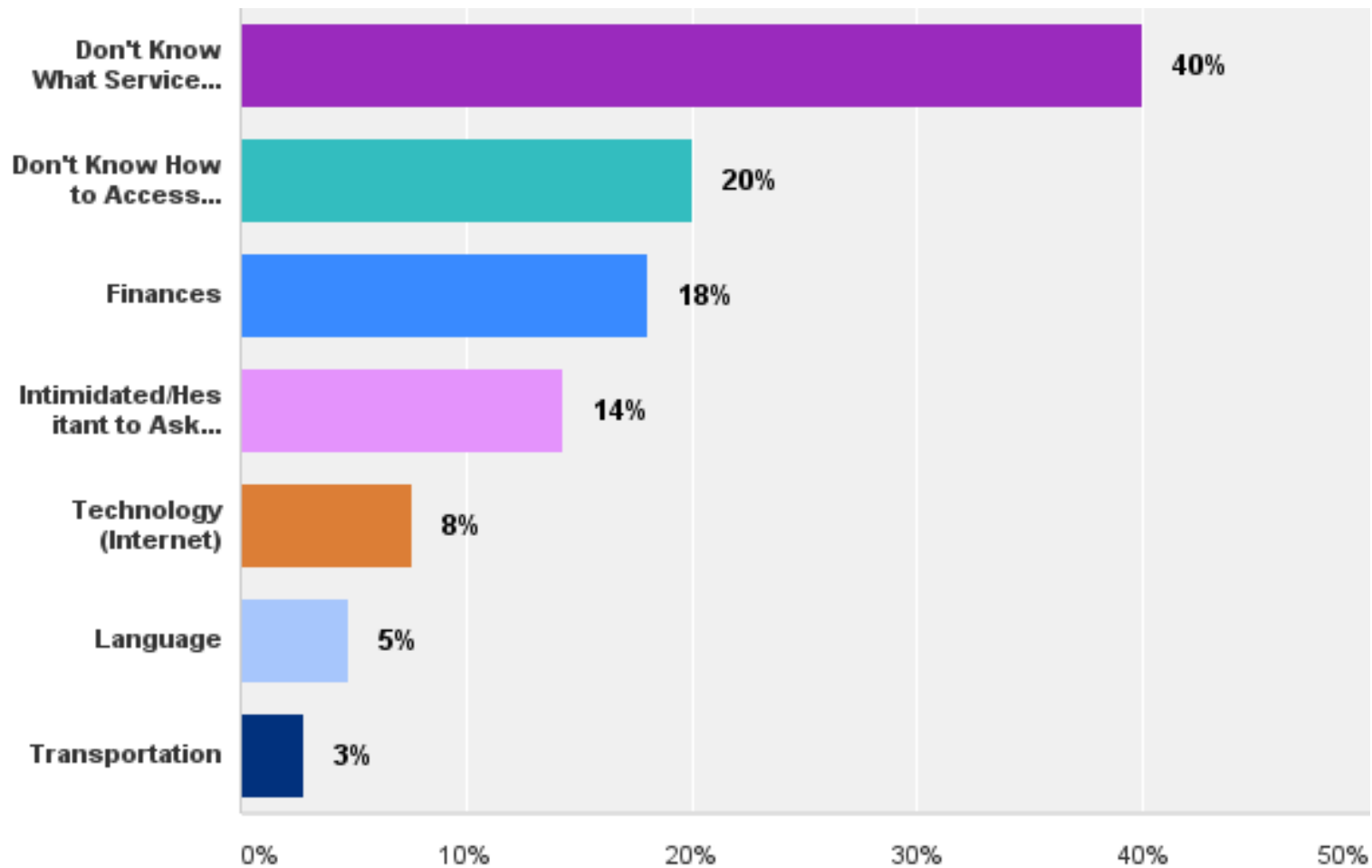


Q4: What type of programs and services would you like?

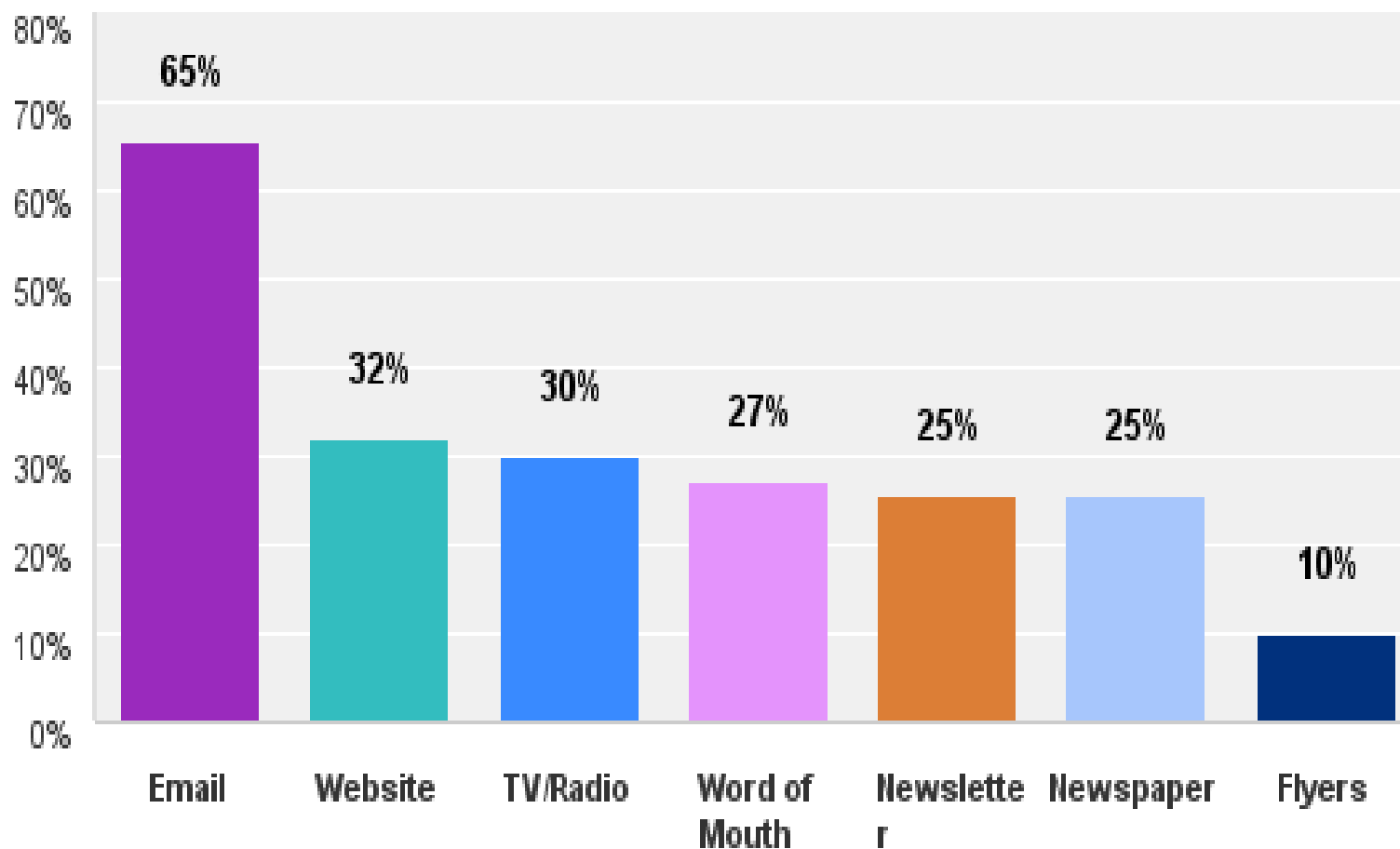

Q5: What are the barriers, if any, preventing you from getting help you may need?

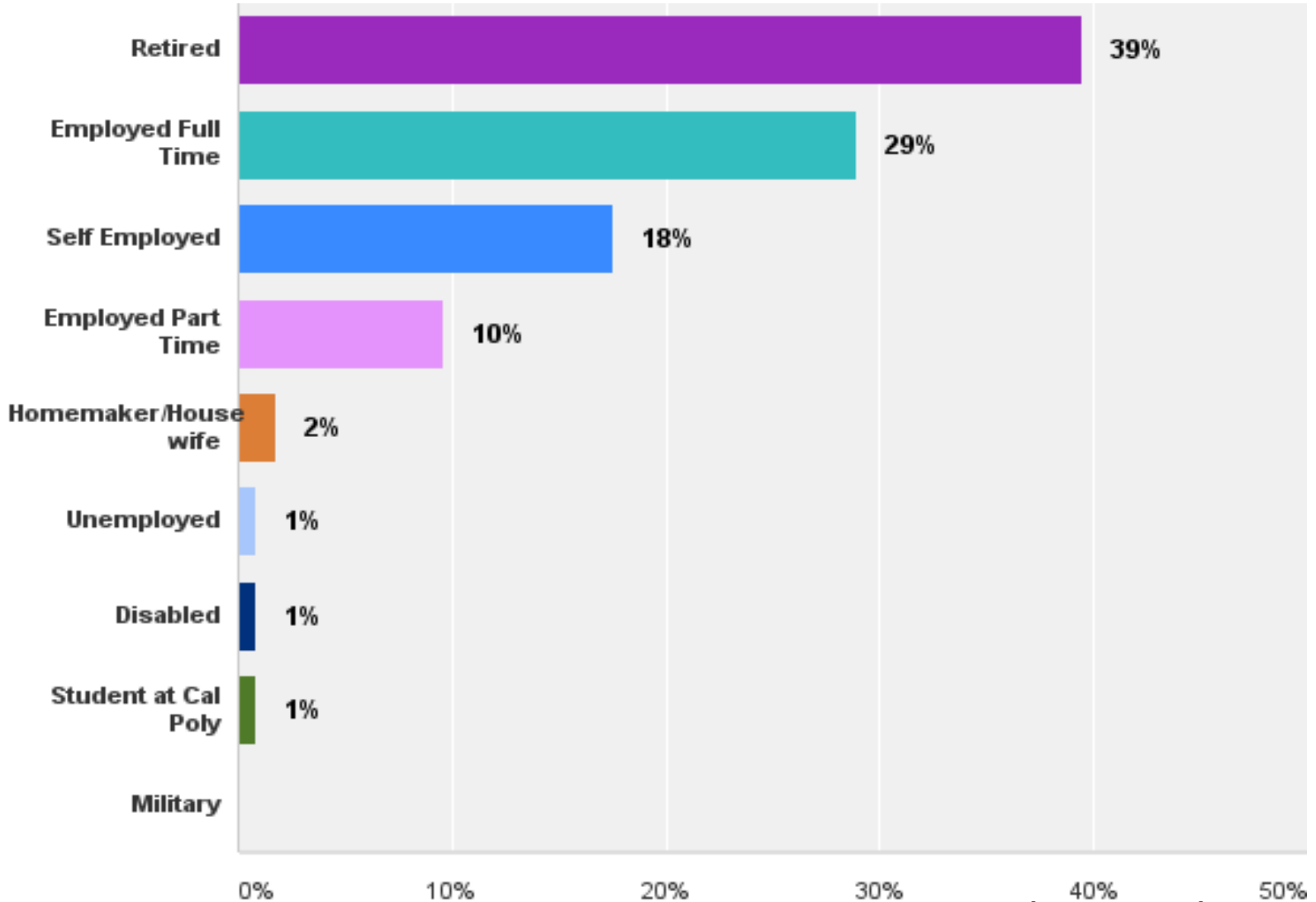


Q6: What is the best way for you to receive information about future programs and services?



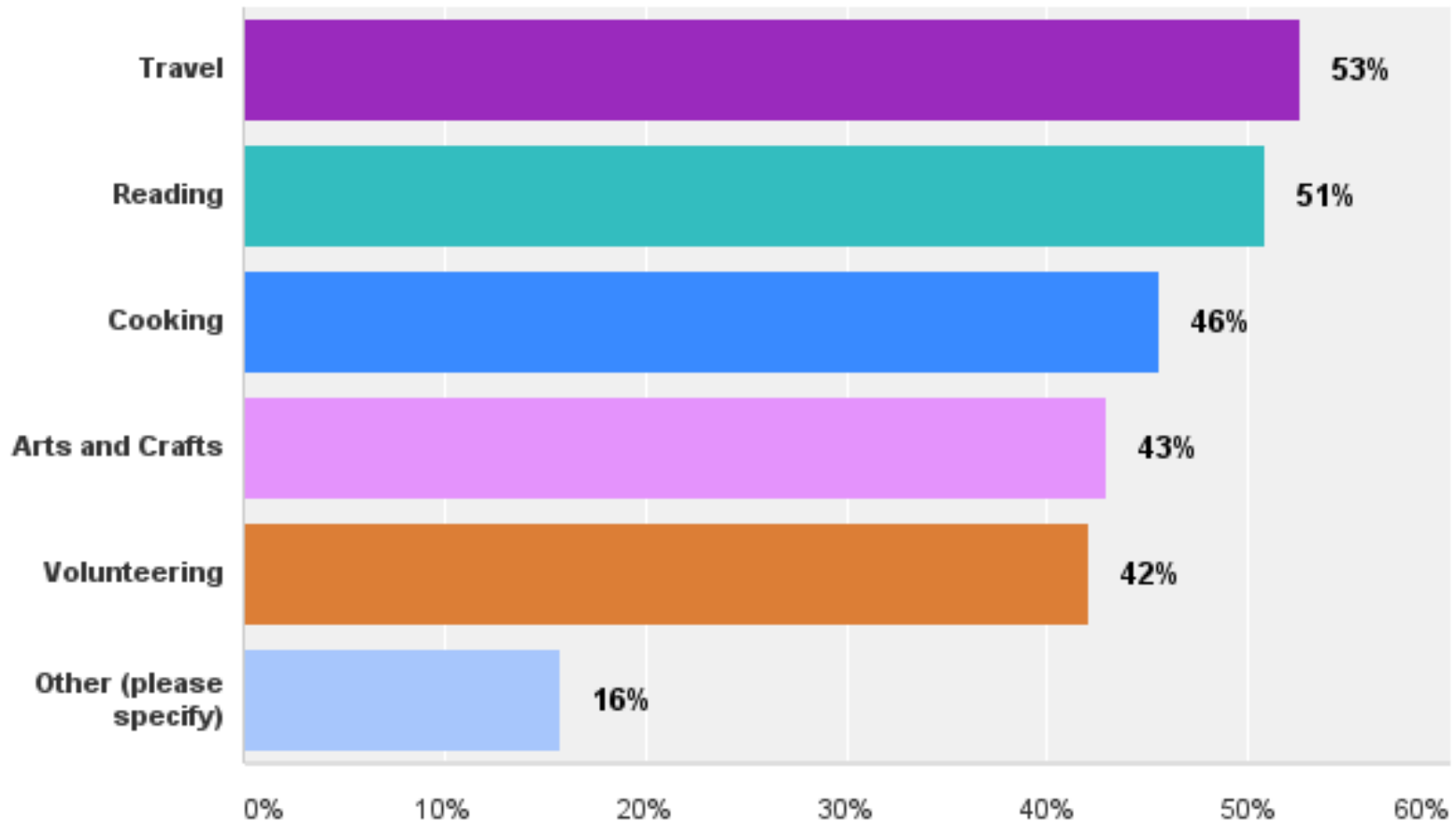
Q7: Which of the following describes your current employment status?

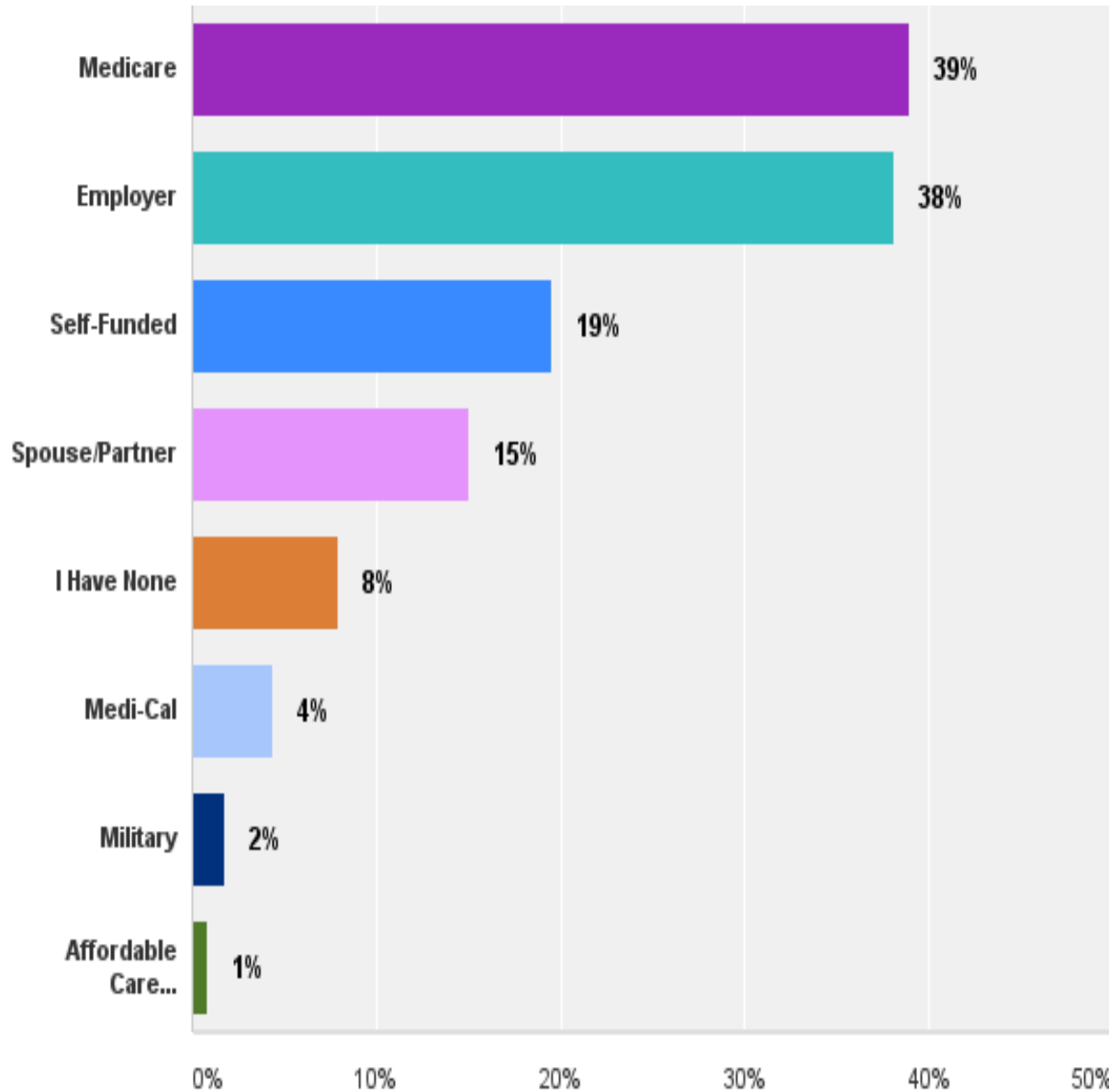


Q10: What are your hobbies/interests?

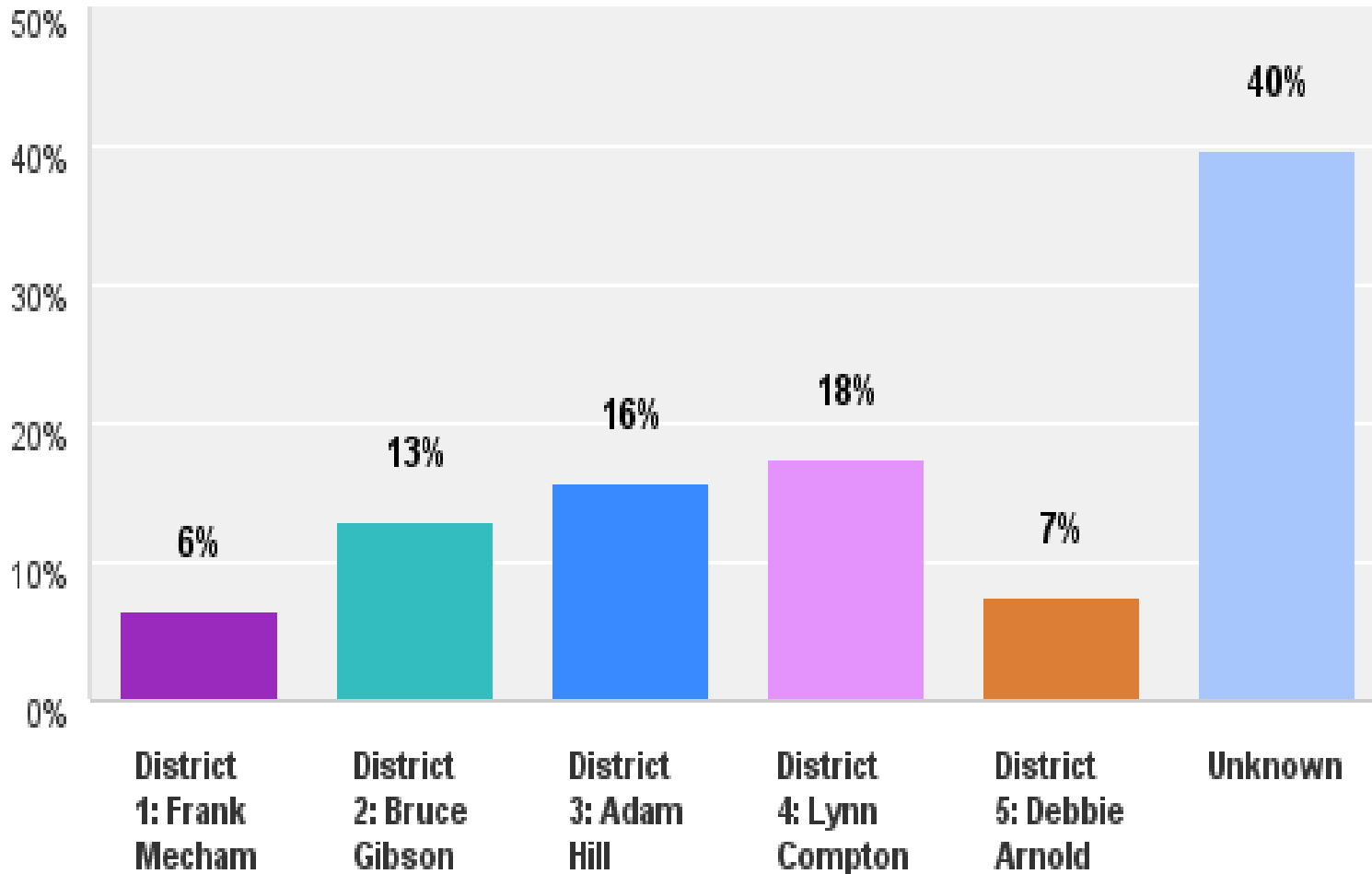


Q11: How is your health care funded?

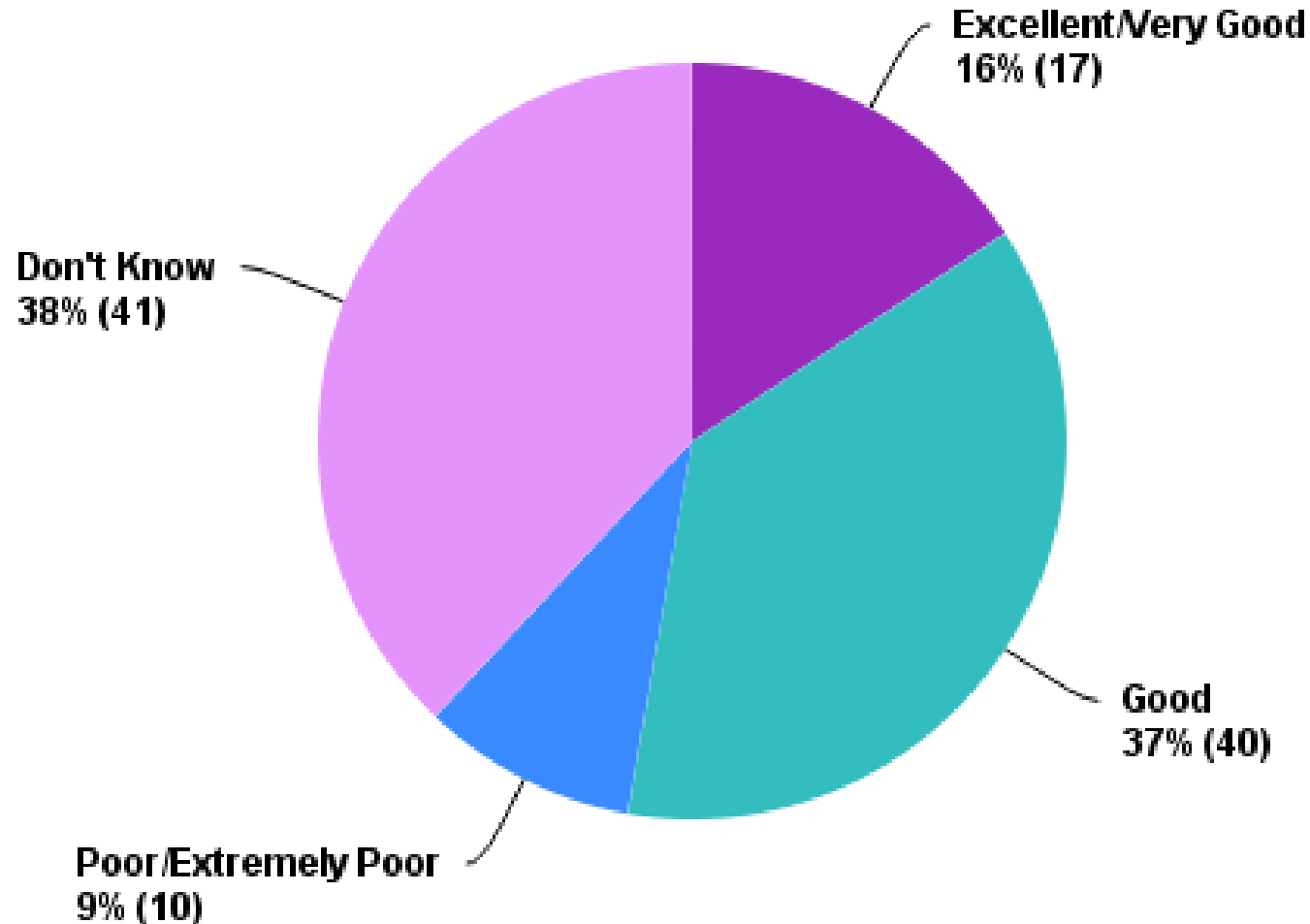

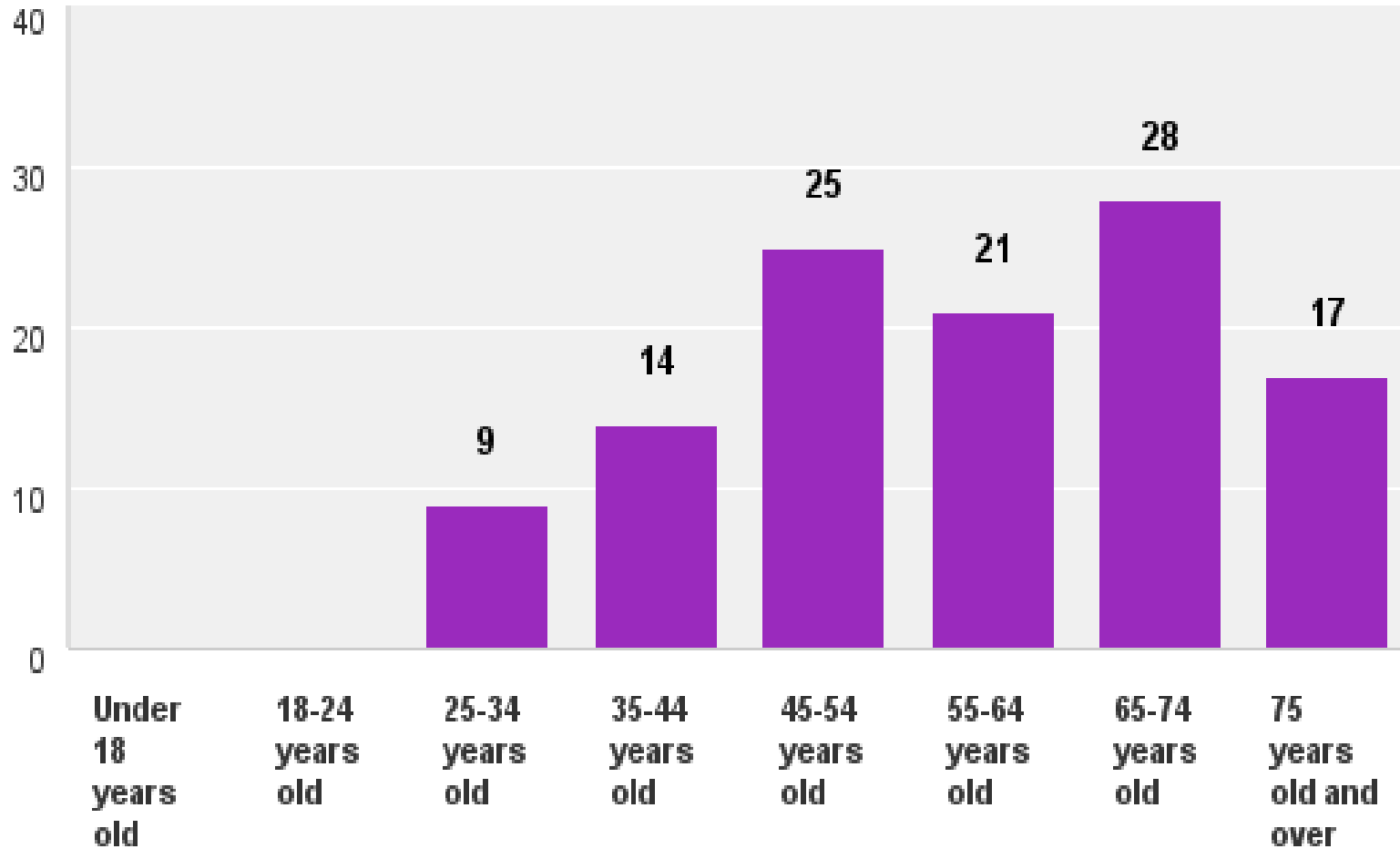

Q13: How well do you think your District Supervisor represents you?



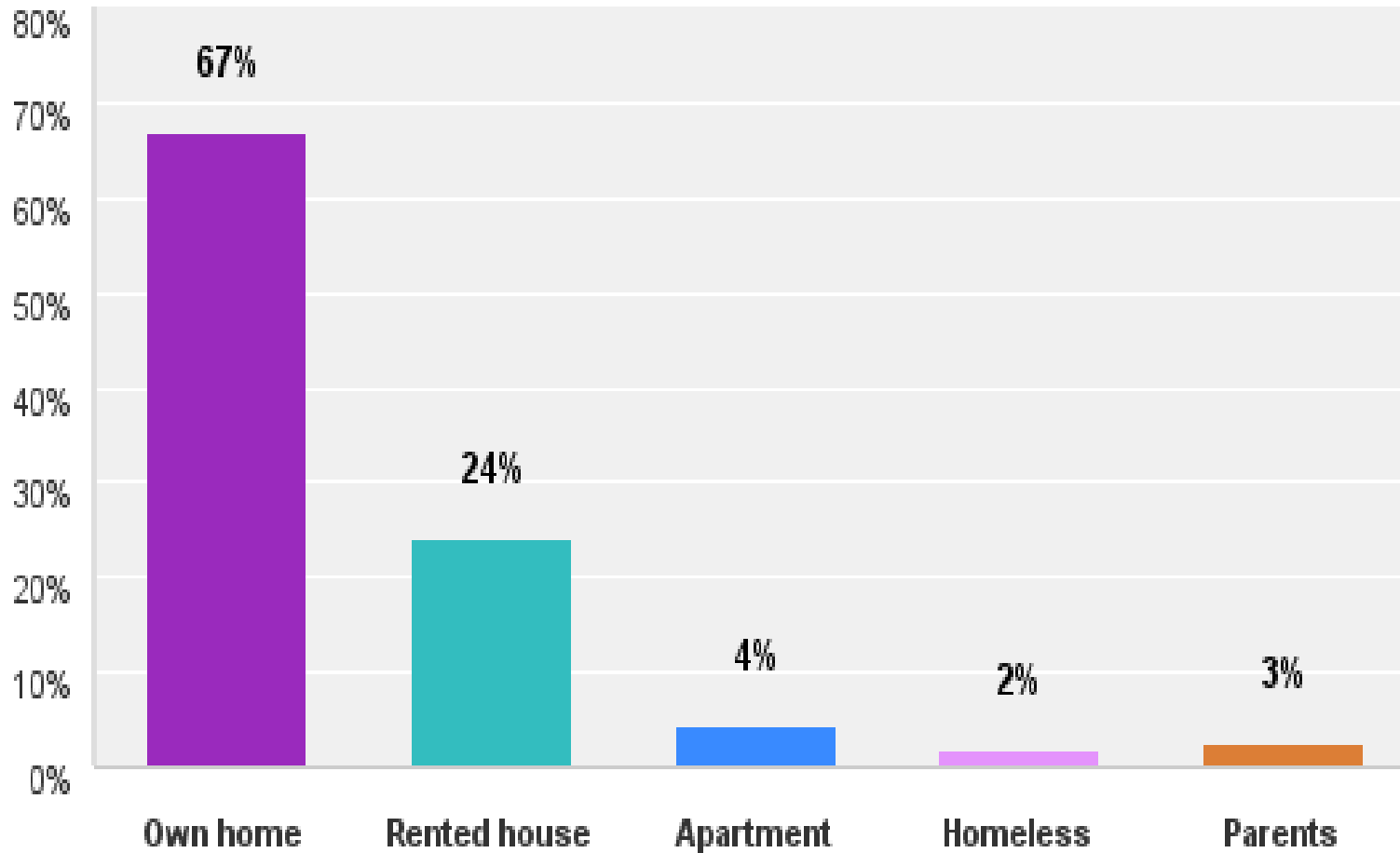
Q14: What is your age?



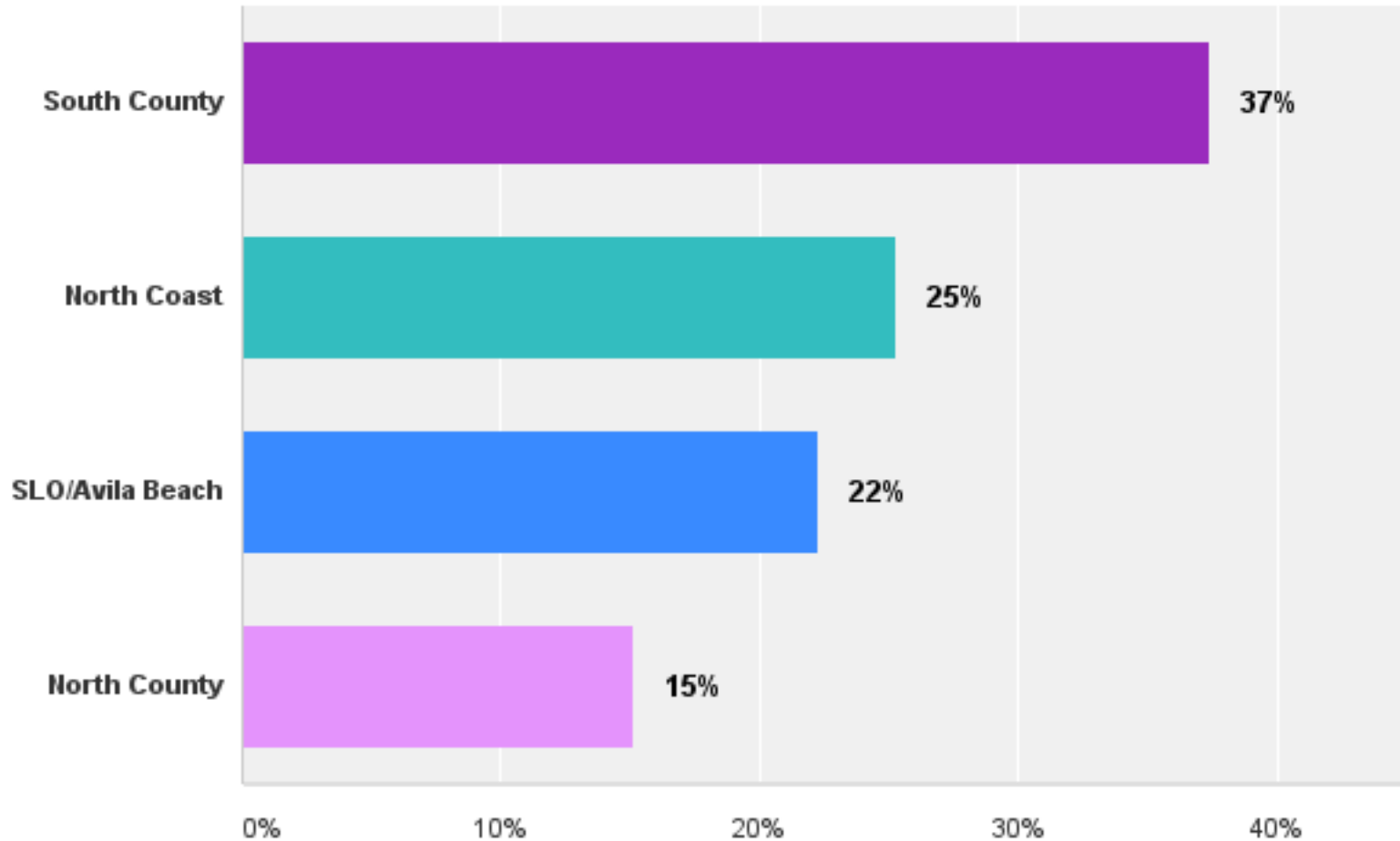
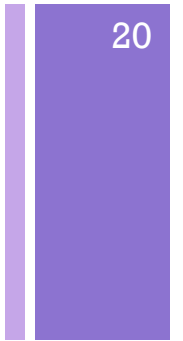

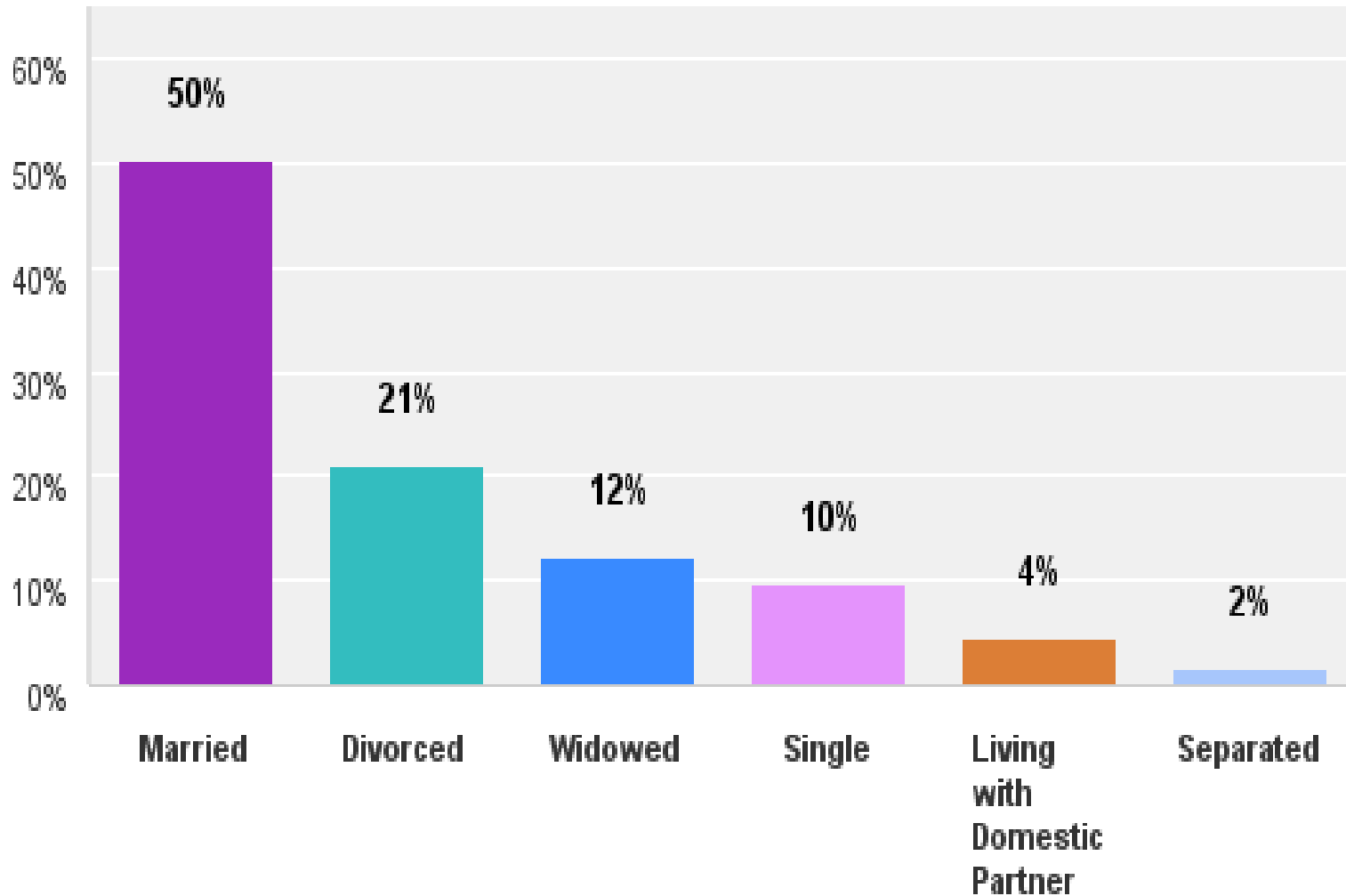


Q16: Where do you live?



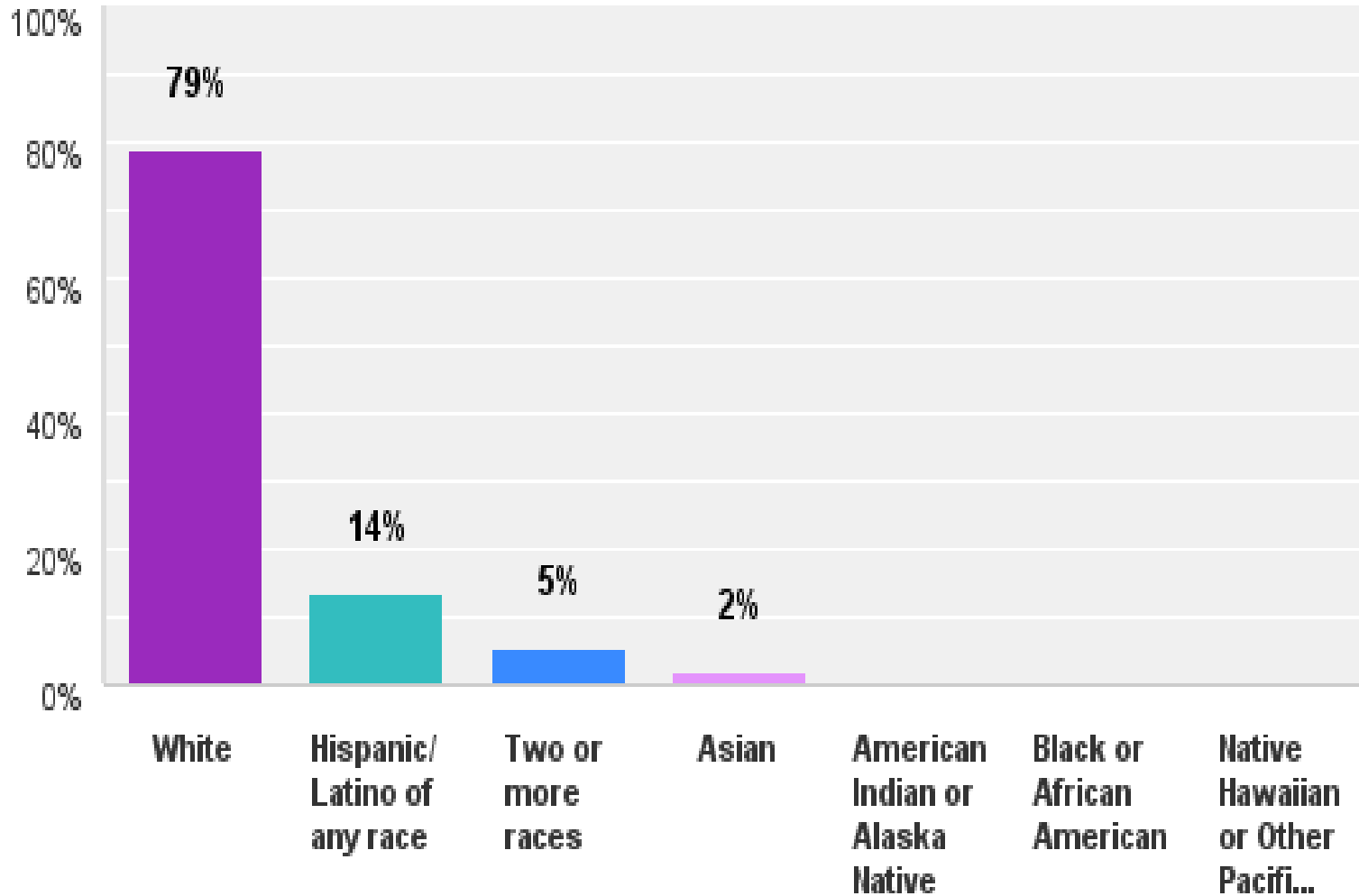
Q17: What is your marital status?

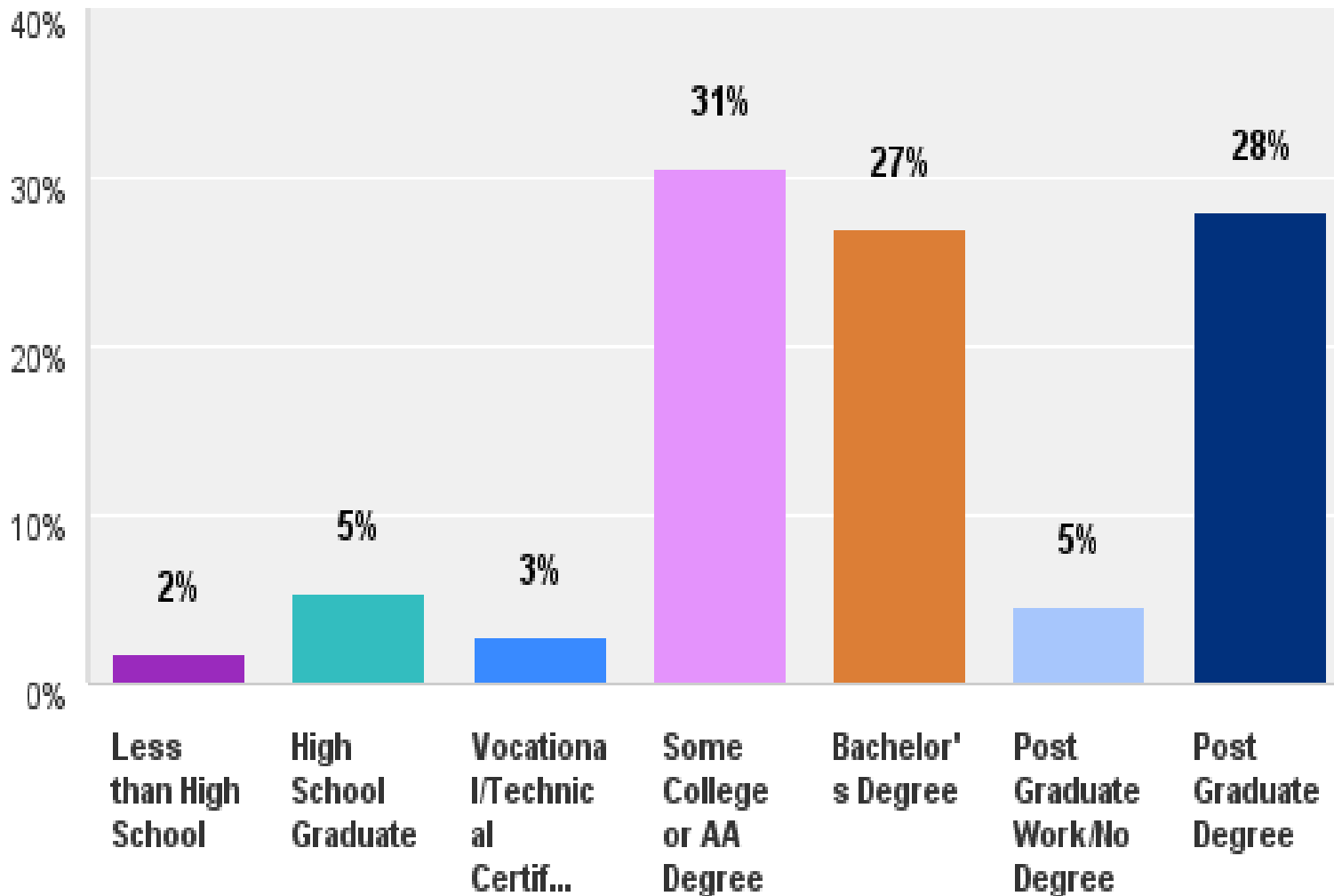
Q19: What is your Race/Ethnicity?
